TAKI

Taki is a popular day trip and weekend getaway from Kolkata. During the winter months, it doubles up as a picnic spot. There are great views of the river and boat trips on the river are enjoyable. Taki also has a couple of temples, ruined mansions and a small mangrove forest.

How to Reach:

By Train:- Nearest Railway station is Taki Road Railway station. It is only 3 KM and takes 10-15 minutes to reach Taki.

By Road: It is well connected by road. Only 80 km from Kolkata





MINI SUNDARBAN GOLPATA FOREST





Golpata Forest is often referred to as Mini Sundarban and one can experience the mangrove forest on a smaller scale. The Golpata Forest of Taki has a calm and peaceful ambience uninterrupted by urban intervention. The Ichamati river, the cool air, the beautiful sunrises and sunsets, and the surrounding Golpata trees soothe your soul. There is a paved pathway that allows you to explore the forest better. Walking in the serene atmosphere amidst the trees provides a magical experience you can cherish for a lifetime.



As it is very ancient temple and dedicated to lord Shiva. Many tourist visit the place. The temple is almost 200 years old. Jora Shiva temple ages back to the 18th century. It is located in a small village called Supur, and there are many legends and stories about who built this magnificent structure. TAKI KULESWARI KALIBARI



Taki Kuleswari Temple is one of the oldest and most traditional temples in the city Taki. According to many locals, the temple is about 300 years old! However, the Natmandir in front of the temple was built much later. The idol of goddess Kali in the temple is very beautiful. There is also a Shiv temple next to the main temple.

PUBER JOMIDAR BARI





This is one of the two very oldest Raj palaces in this Region. There are some antique collection in the Rajbari. The building is very ancient and it could be one of the prime tourist attraction in Taki. Now many tourists visit the place.

SEHERA DWEEP (ISLAND)





This is a growing island between the Sandeshkhali I and Hingulgunj Development Block in the Dansha River. It is near Kumirmari Island under Rupmari GP of Hingulgunj Block. The island is covered by deep Mangrove Forest. Many migratory birds used to come throughout the year.



SAMSERNAGAR AND HEMNAGAR

Samsernagar is a small village at the extreme part of India Bangladesh Border. Located beside Rai Mongol River and Kalindi river. This small village is situated within the last civilized Island before Bangladesh within India. It's geographic location is very much interesting. The river Kalindi is flowing on the left side of the village. Tourist can see Bangladesh on the opposite side of the village. Other side of the village is Sundarban Tiger Reserve (Jhingekhali Beat) which is just 50 meters away from the village. This small village is rich in rural culture and local activities and most of the people is attached with farming and local works.

Hemnagar is the border of the world's largest mangrove forest "Sundarban", and is a village on the banks of the Raimangal River. It is another gateway of Sundarban from North 24 Parganas District. Boat rides through creeks, visits to the fishermen's bay, mangroves forest, village tours are organized here.

How to Reach:

By Train:- Nearest Railway Station is Hasnabad (51 KM).

By Road: It is well connected by road from Barasat to Lebukhali Ferry Ghat and Dulduli Ferry Ghat to Samsernagar.

By Ferry:- Ferry service is available every one hour between Lebukhali Ferry Ghat and Dulduli Ferry Ghat and Car can cross the river by Vessel.



PIR GORACHAND MAZAR





The Sufi Saint or Pir Hazrat Shah Abbas Ali Razi or Makki popularly known as Pir Gorachand. He came to India in the 14th century and preached Islam in 24 Parganas of present West Bengal with many difficulties and obstructions. He was born in Mecca in 693 Hizri(?) or 1294 C.E. His Mazar is situated at Haroa near the bank of Vidyadhari river. A Pir, a Saint, a savior of human irrespective of religion, caste and creed, Pir Gorachand is also a religious preacher, who showed path for living worldly life among his disciples (murid). He fought a battle with Raja Chandraketu to establish Islam in South West Bengal and died of his injuries in 12th Falgun, 1322 C.E.

By Train:- Nearest Railway Station is Harua Road (7.5 KM).

By Road: It is well connected by road from Kolkata and Barasat.



KACHUA DHAM



Kachua Dham is a most popular Pilgrimage among the Hindu religions. It's considered as the birth place of Lacknath Baba. Every year many visitors visit here from far away. Especially due to Lokenath Baba's Birthday ceremony, a huge number of people come here.

How to Reach:

By Train: Nearest Railway Station is Kankra Mirjanagar (3 KM).

By Road: It is well connected by road from Kolkata and Barasat.

CHAKLA





Chakla near Berachapa (Station Guma/ Bira is a well-known Religious Tourist Place of Bengal for Lokenath Baba Temple. It's famous world wide for the Temple of Lokenath Bramhachari Baba (Thakur / Guru Ji). Since, Chakla is the Birthplace of Lokenath Baba.

How to Reach:

By Train:- Nearest Railway Station is Guma (12 KM).

By Road: It is well connected by road from Kolkata and Barasat.



CHANDRAKETUGARH

Chandraketugarh is located in the district of North 24 Parganas, only 38 km. north-east of Kolkata. The history of Chandraketugarh dated back to almost the 3rd Century B.C., during the pre-Mauryan era. Historians identify this site with the ancient Gangaridai mentioned by the Greek traveller, Megasthenes, in his work 'Indika'. Now there is a Museum.

How to Reach:

By Train:- Nearest Railway Station is Haroa Road (5 KM).

By Road: It is well connected by road from Barasat, (22 KM via Taki Road).



CHANDRAKETUGARH MUSEUM





The Chandraketugarh museum was inaugurated by the Hon'ble chief Minister Smt Mamata Banerjee on 11th January 2019. A part of archaeological finds is displayed in this Museum which was collected by late Dilip Kumar Maite, a local personality has interest in the past legacy of Chandraketugarh. Dilip Kumar Maite collected total 524 nos antiquities from this site of Chandraketugarh. Total no of antiquities displayed in Museum gallery is 244 no. and 280 no. antiquities is in Storage Room(Museum Collection) There is a Curator of the Museum who guides the tourist.

DUTTAPUKUR POTTERY MARKET

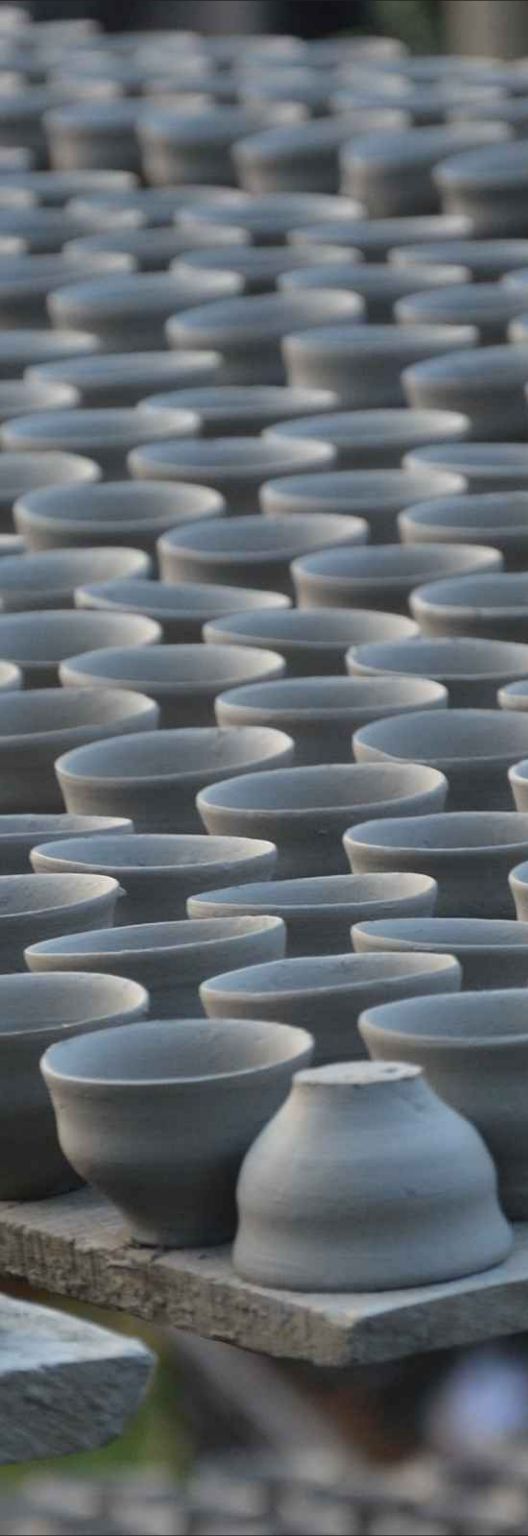


Duttapukur (Pal Para) in the North 24 Parganas district is where clay lamps and earthen diyas are produced on a large scale. The potters here mass-manufacture diyas, which are then sold in various markets across the country. They also make clay pot, Plate, Water Bottles. Various types of Hindu Idols like Laxmi-Ganesh, Sarswati, Ganesh are also made in large scale here. Terracotta work of this region is also very famous.

On the banks of Sukhabati river in Amdanga, Shankar Chakraborty (Commander and Chief Instructor of Maharaja Pratapaditya) established this Karunamoyee Kali Temple.

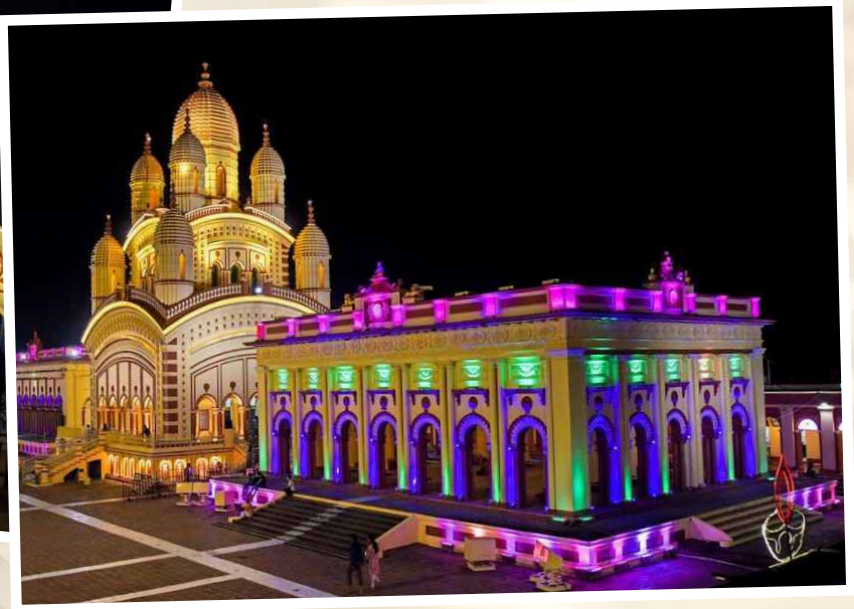

DAKSHINESWAR KALI TEMPLE





Dakshineswar Kali Temple is a Hindu temple located in Dakshineswar near Kolkata. Situated on the eastern bank of the Hooghly River, the presiding deity of the temple is Bhavatarini. The temple was built by Rani Rashmoni, a philanthropist and a devotee of Kali in 1855. The temple is famous for its association with Ramakrishna, a mystic of 19th Century Bengal.

the Dakshineswar Rani Rashmoni Skywalk, consisting of 14 escalators, four lifts and staircases, has been constructed with the stated aim of easing the journey of tourists and devotees to the historic Dakshineswar Kali temple, which attracts 1.4 crore people annually.

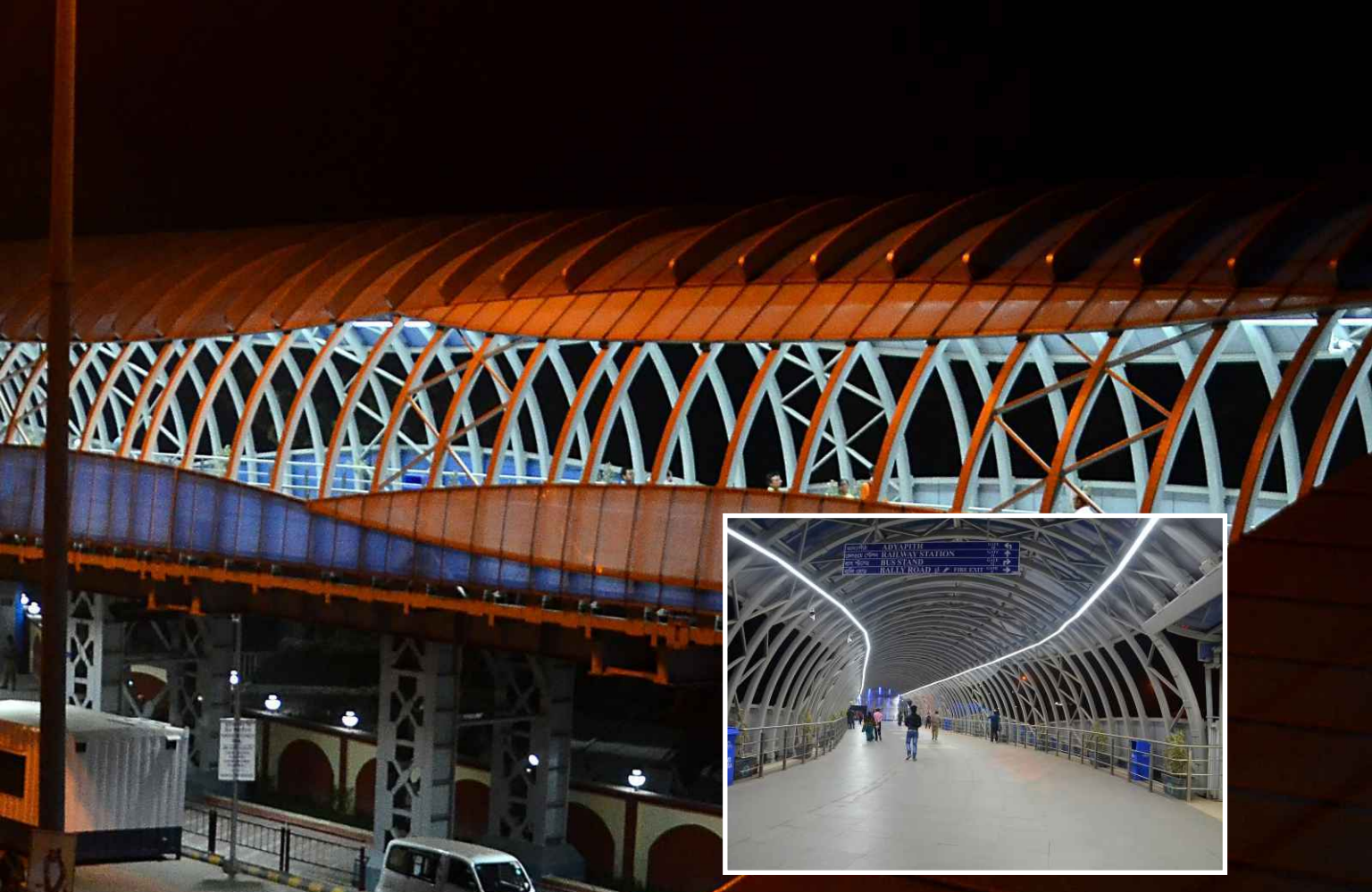

ADYAPITH





Close to Dakshineswar temple is Adyapith, a pilgrim centre, the temple of Adya Ma. Sree Annada Thakur being advised in a dream had built this temple of 'Adya Ma' in order to teach man the dictums of love and idealism. The construction was started in 1340 BS and the temple was inaugurated on Makar Sankranti (last day of Bengali calendar month Poush) in 1375 BS.

On this bottom is a murti of Sri Ramakrishna with word "Guru" inscribed nearby on this middle altar is a replica of the murti of Adya Ma found by Ananda Thakur in the Eden Garden. This murti is made of 8 metals. Nearby inscribed "Knowledge and Work". Topmost of adorned by the murtis of Radha & Krishna. Known all over the world as Divine Couple. Love is written on the altar . One hour before sunrise Mangalarati starts, at 10.30 is Bhogarati, 1.5 hours after sunrise is Sitalarati.

ANNAPURNA TEMPLE

The majestic Temple stands on the Rani Rashmoni ghat near Barrackpore. The temple similar to Dakshineswar Temple at Titagrah on the river bank, was opened to devotees on the 12th of April, 1875 (30th Chaitra 1281) by Sri Sri Ramkrishna Paramahansa. The Temple was built by Rani Rashmoni's Youngest daughter Jagadamba Devi. She was married to Mathur Mohan Biswas who, after the death of his first wife, Rani Rashmoni's second daughter Karunamoyi, married Jagadamba Devi

GANDHI GHAT

Located at Barrackpore. A tomb in the memory of Mahatma Gandhi, a lush green garden dotted with 120 varieties of roses, exquisite plants and trees, a picturesque sunset and an exciting riverfront ' the Gandhi Ghat package is good enough to entice you to break free from crowded Kolkata and set off for Barrackpore, around 30 km north from the heart of the city. Built in 1948 (the year the father of the nation died), the monument on the banks of the river Hooghly and the sprawling garden, Jawahar Kunj ' maintained by the state forest department ' can offer a day's respite to city-dwellers. It was inaugurated by Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru.

GANDHI MUSEUM

Gandhi Smarak Sangrahalaya or more aptly the Memorial Museums set up on Mahatma Gandhi at the behest of Gandhi Memorial Trust.

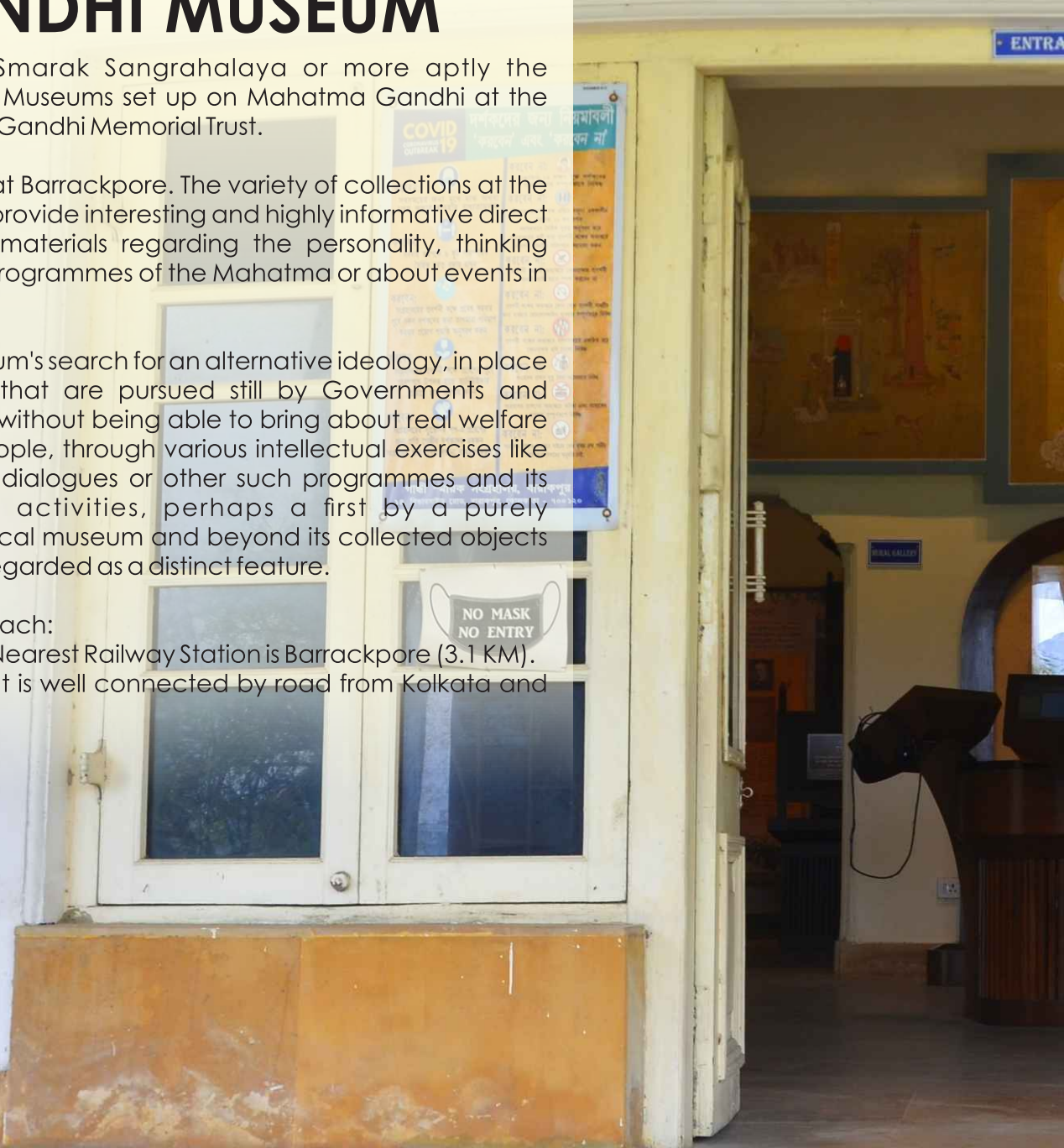

The museum's search for an alternative ideology, in place of those that are pursued still by Governments and countries without being able to bring about real welfare of the people, through various intellectual exercises like seminars, dialogues or other such programmes and its research activities, perhaps a first by a purely biographical museum and beyond its collected objects must be regarded as a distinct feature.

MANGAL PANDEY PARK

Located at Barrackpore in North 24 Parganas. This park has been dedicated to the famous freedom fighter, Mangal Pandey. He was a soldier in Barrackpore Cantonment who rose in rebellion against the British. He ended up wounding two British Officer with his musket and sword. He was thus court martialled and hung to death on April 8, 1857. This park also has a statue of Mangal Pandey and a memorial dedicated to him in the park. There is a small baby elephant statue raising his trunk in mark of respect in front of Mangal Pandey's statue.

Bankim Sangrahashala is the library museum of Rishi Bankim Chandra Chattopadhyay, the great novelist and poet of India. It is located at Kanthalpara, Naihati in the North 24 Paraganas. Established in 1954, the museum occupies only a portion of the big ancestral house, located alongside. Notably, Bankim Sangrahashala (Museum) has become one of the most sought after places nearby Kolkata over the years. The spot is significant because Rishi Bankim Chandra wrote and composed the national song of India, Vande Mataram over here. The heritage museum is a living testimony of the fact that the other great personalities of pre-independent India like Rishi Aurobindo Ghosh, Chittaranjan Das, Dinabandhu Mitra, Keshab Chandra Sen, etc., used to come here for spending some quality time in this peaceful ambiance along with the great poet and author.

How to Reach: By Train:- Nearest Railway Station is Naihati (400 M).

By Road: It is well connected by road from Kolkata and Barasat.

By Ferry:- Ferry service is available from Naihati to Chuchura.

The house and ashram of the famous poet and religious figure Sadhak Ramprasad is located at Halisahar village of North 24 Parganas, a famous place rich with heritage and cultural importance. It is the birthplace of Ramprasad Sen who was one of the most famous devotees of Goddess Kali. Ramprasad is remembered for the songs and poems he composed which is known as Ramprasadi Sangeet. The Ramprasadi tune known for its distinctness had influenced numerous later day poet-composers including Rabindranath. Ramprasad was a close friend of Maharaja Krishnachandra of Nadia. Ramprasad performed his sadhana here in his Panchamundi Asana, thus this place is also known locally as 'Panchabati Temple'.

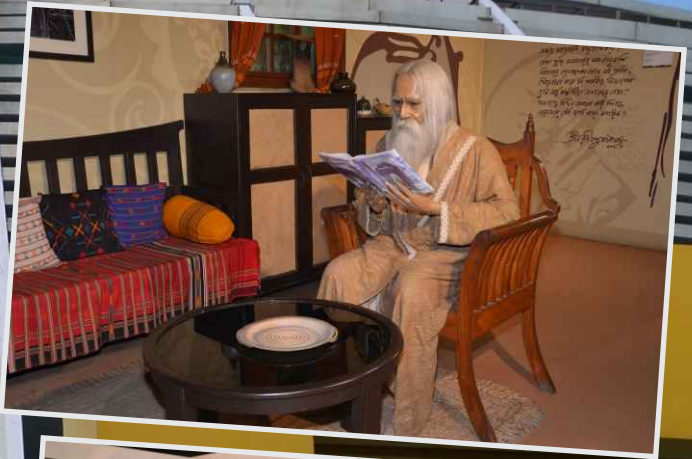
MOTHER'S WAX MUSEUM

ECO PARK

The park is also called Prakriti Tirtha and is a hit among locals who often hop here to spend weekends.

The Eco Tourism Park is divided into three major sections of urban recreational spaces namely- Ecological zone, Theme gardens and Open spaces for recreation. There are numerous activities that are available for the visitors of every age, some of which include zorbing, kayaking, cycling, rowing activities, paddle boating or speed boat rides.

HOUSE OF DINABANDHU MITRA

The house of Dinabandhu Mitra is located at the Chouberia in Gopalnagar of Bongaon sub-division. Dinabandhu Mitra was the noted play writer of Bengal and inspired a revolt through his work Nildarpan which provided a vivid account of the tortures and oppressions of the indigo planters of the Bengal on the villagers.

Bankim Chandra Chattopadhyay pointed out the role played by this work in inspiring the indigo revolt was similar to that of Uncle Tom's Cabin by Harriet Beecher Stowe behind the US Civil War. Dinabandhu, as the Post-Master had an opportunity of going around through different villages of Bengal and Nildarpan, was the outcome of his observations during these trips.

HOUSE OF BIBHUTIBHUSHAN BANDOP

The house of Bibhutibhushan Bandopadhyay is located in Gopalnagar of Bongaon sub-division. Bibhutibhushan was one of the stalwarts of Bengali literature and a noted Bengali novelist of the post-Rabindranath era. Although he had a strong will and interest for higher education but had to quit it after graduation due to poverty and took the job of a school teacher in Bongaon High School. Later he taught in different schools all around in Bengal and also worked in Bhagalpur at the Kachhari of the zamindar Khelat Chandra Ghose.

His original house was located in the village in Bongaon on the banks of the Ichamati River. Bibhutibhushan spent most of his life in this house. He reconstructed his small house on the banks of Ichamati and named it after one of his works Sesherkheya. Bibhutibhushan died in 1950, in Ghatsila.

BIBHUTIBHUSHAN WILDLIFE SANCTUARY

Bibhuti Bhushan Wildlife Sanctuary which was erstwhile known as Parmadan Forest, is located on the bank of Icchamati river in the (North) 24 Paraganas district of West Bengal. It was declared a wildlife sanctuary in 1980 to pay tribute to the famous Bengali writer Bibhutibhusan Bandhyopadhyay, who hails from a nearby village.

Paramadan forest is around 100 km by road from Kolkata which is just 3 hours drive from Kolkata and quite close to Indo-Bangladesh border. The place accupies around 227 acres of land. A beautiful place for spending fun filled weekend trip. The Paramadan forest sanctuary is also a safe abode for a health population of approximately 300 deers and is also a heaven for bird spotters.

How to Reach:

By Train:- Nearest Railway Station is Bongaon (25 KM).

By Road: It is well connected by road from Bongoan, Barasat and Kolkata.



BERI PANCHPOTA ECO-TOURISM

Beri Panchpota Eco-Tourism has five horse-shape lakes at Gaighata Block in North 24 Parganas district of West Bengal. The "Beri Baor" (Lake) probably the biggest ox-bow lake in India. It is a beautiful weekend gate-away from Kolkata for one day or more to Nature Lover people. This beautiful tourist spot located near Bangladesh Border. This mirror type clean water surface of the lake and greenery cover village environment gives the peaceful look. The biggest lake was a part of Ichhamati river, later the river took a turn and it has left some water surface which is now self-dependent water body called 'Baor'

The green horizon, expanded all over the locality, is the added attraction.. The chirping of various birds will attract the nature lover's heart. They will forget their gruff mind while watching the 250 years old Shiv temple beside 'Nil Kuthi' and tourist's lung will fulfill with two country's lucid air. The evening boating on the lake will add the cherry on the cake and the Ramkrishna Mission in the greenery and their environment will destroy the tourist loneliness.
